our ongoing exploration of the unjustly overlooked **David Allan Coe** catalog. A life-long renegade, Coe has been one of the most colorful and unpredictable characters in country music...or *any* music. An outlaw pioneer, he didn't score many big hits, although he wrote several big hits for others...including *Would You Lay With Me In A Field Of Stone* and *Take This Job And Shove It*. He was also incredibly prolific: during thirteen years with **Columbia Records**, he released almost two LPs a year. Here, we focus on the years **1982-1985**.

'Rough Rider' and 'DAC' come from 1982 and the mostly self-composed songs chart Coe's tempestuous life during this time. As Coe himself says, **"Here's another chapter in the never-ending romance of David Allan Coe's life."** Based in Florida, he was not only writing enough great songs to fill two LPs, but a book about his prison experience (and how to survive prison...if you happen to be there). Coe himself provides detailed song-by-song commentaries, mapping the words to his life.

Every one of these three CDs not only includes two original LPs, but **bonus material** where it's available. Add these CDs to the six already released by Bear Family, and you're starting to build a collection of one of the most singular and underrated talents of our time. Share the DAC adventure!
