

Invigorated by a critically acclaimed new album, invitations to open at major venues for Neko Case and The White Stripes, and a guest appearance on CBS-TV's 'The Late Show with David Letterman,' country music icon Porter Wagoner was riding on a late-career resurgence when he died October 26, 2007 after a brief illness.

Mainstream audiences best knew the lanky, rhinestone-suited singer as a symbol of 'old Nashville' and a longtime member of The Grand Ole Opry. Longtime country music fans remembered Wagoner as the popular television personality who gave Dolly Parton her big break. But a younger audience embraced him for the dark, nightmarish concept albums he made for RCA Victor during the late sixties.

'Confessions Of A Broken Man,' 'The Bottom Of The Bottle' and 'Down In The Alley' introduced Wagoner's alter ego, 'Skid Row Joe.' Once a successful family man, Joe was a disheveled, panhandling alcoholic. 'Soul Of A Convict' revealed the world of prison inmates and their long-suffering families. 'The Cold Hard Facts Of Life' explored the minds

and motivations of murderers, philanderers and the down-and-out. 'The Carroll County Accident' was built around Wagoner's country and pop chart hit about two respected citizens, a fatal wreck and a missing wedding ring.

With songs penned by such writers as Bill Anderson, Merle Haggard, Waylon Jennings, Willie Nelson, Dolly Parton and Mel Tillis, Wagoner's mind-numbing country noir sagas are filled with as much despair as any low-budget grindhouse movie or cheesy paperback novel. Since their original release, these albums gained a cult following among the psychotronic set, alt-country fans and the Goth subculture. After being out of print for more than two decades, they're available once again in glorious stereo from the original two-track mixdown tapes.
