

SALES NOTES

From raucous rockers like *You Made A Hit*, to rhythmic rompers like *So Young*, and on to *Sail Away* and other amazingly memorable ballads. Many of his songs were written by Charlie Rich, who plays piano on this CD, including the original model for Jerry Lee Lewis's *Breakup*. You can hear them all on this CD, sung in Ray's strong voice - warm, controlled, yet always on the edge.

But Sun is only half the early Ray Smith story. After recording for Sam Phillips in Memphis, Ray took his classy act to Judd Records, owned by Sam's brother, Jud, where he registered one of the best rock-pop hits of the late 1950s, *Rockin' Little Angel*. Using the best Nashville sessionmen, Ray's Judd recordings reveal an even wider range of his vocal abilities.

Kentucky-born Smith melded his country roots with a great ability to sing rockers and pop ballads, and he had his moments of fame on 'American Bandstand' and in the clubs of Vegas. He recorded throughout the 1960s and 1970s but he never realised his full potential, becoming no stranger to the bottle and to bouts of depression. He committed suicide in his adopted home of Canada in 1979.
